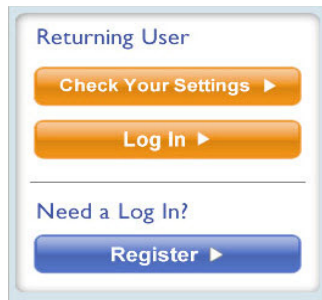
This guide explains how to register for a SuccessNet Plus teacher account.

Overview

SuccessNet Plus is the new Pearson learning management system that enables educators to organize and deliver Pearson content and customized content. Teachers can assign assessments that personalize learning by creating individualized study plans and adjusting learner levels (features vary by product).

Step 1 – Click Register

Go to SuccessNetPlus.com. Click **Register** to begin the registration process.



Step 2 – Get Started

Click **Get Started** in the Teachers section on the left, and then certify that you are a teacher.



Step 3 – Do you have a school code?

A School Code is the unique number that Pearson assigns to each school and will identify you as a teacher at a specific school building. If you already have a school code, click **Enter your School Code** and skip to Step 5. If you need to request a School Code, click **Request a School Code** and go to Step 4.

Step 4 – Request a School Code

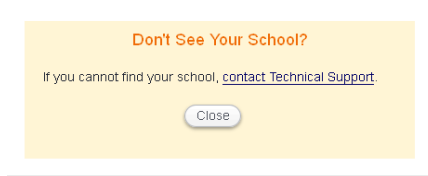
Enter your school e-mail address. Then, begin typing either your school name or zip code. School names appear. Select your school and click **Request**.

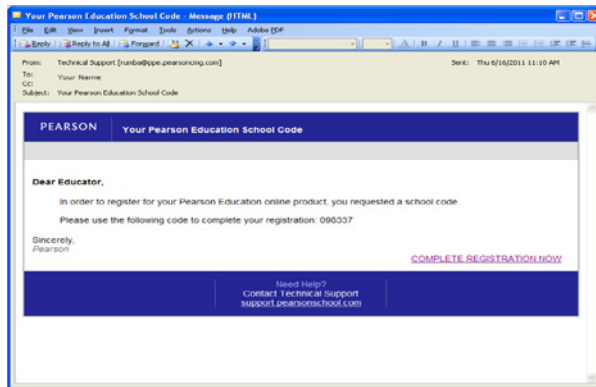
If you are unsure of your school's formal name or are having difficulty finding your school, click **Advanced School Search** and enter search criteria, such as your city name, state, and zip code, and then click **Search**. Select your school in the Results list and click **Request**.

If you don't see your school in the list, click **Don't see your school?** and then click the **contact Technical Support** link and complete the form.

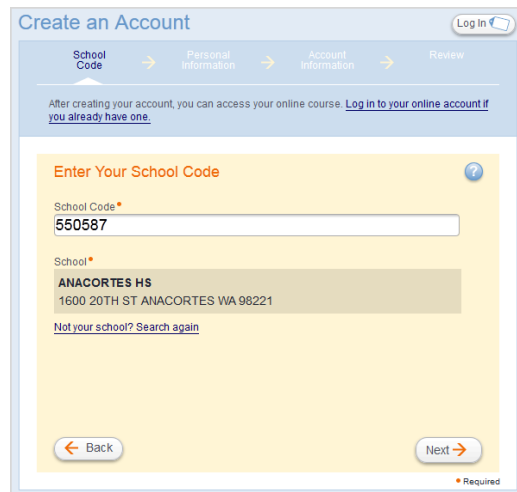


If you successfully selected your school in the list, you will receive your school code in an e-mail. Click the **COMPLETE REGISTRATION NOW** link to finish your registration. All teachers in your school will use the same school code, so you can provide this code to other teachers who belong to your school.



Step 5 – Enter Your School Code

Enter your School Code. Type your school name or zip code into the School field until school names appear. Select your school. If you have trouble finding your school name, click the **Advanced School Search** link and enter search criteria, such as your city name, state, and zip code, and then click **Search**. Select your school in the Results list. After entering your school code and selecting your school name, click **Next**.



Step 6 – Personal Information

Enter your name and e-mail address. Important information regarding system updates will be sent to this e-mail. We suggest using your school e-mail address. Click **Next**.

Step 7 – Account Information

Enter a user name. By default, your e-mail address will appear in the user name field. You may change your user name if you desire. Enter a password. Passwords must be at least eight alphanumeric characters long and contain at least one number or special character, such as @, #, or *. Retype your password in the **Confirm Password** field. Write down your user name and password and save it in a safe place for future reference. Click **Next**.
