


In the Table of Contents, click **Unit Resources**. Click a unit you would like to explore.

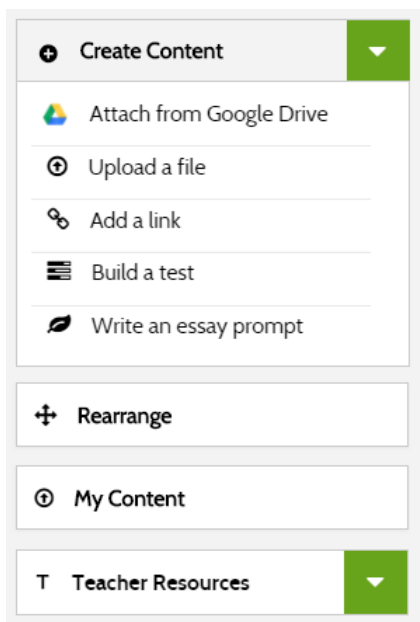
In the Table of Contents, click **Unit Resources**. Then click **Program Level Resources**.

- These program-level resources include graphic organizers such as the First-Read Guide, Close-Read Guide, and Evidence Log.
- The graphic organizers are editable PDFs which allows students to type in them directly and save their work. The graphic organizers can also be assigned to students and returned to the teacher.

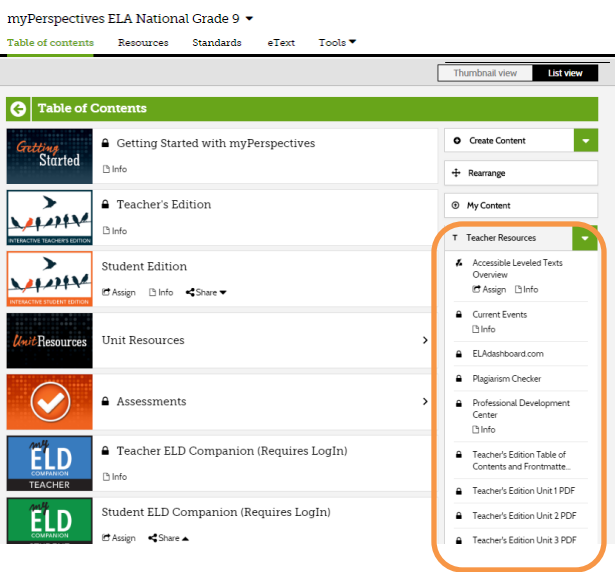
Explore the following customization options on the right-hand navigation bar: **Create Content**, **Rearrange**, and **My Content**.

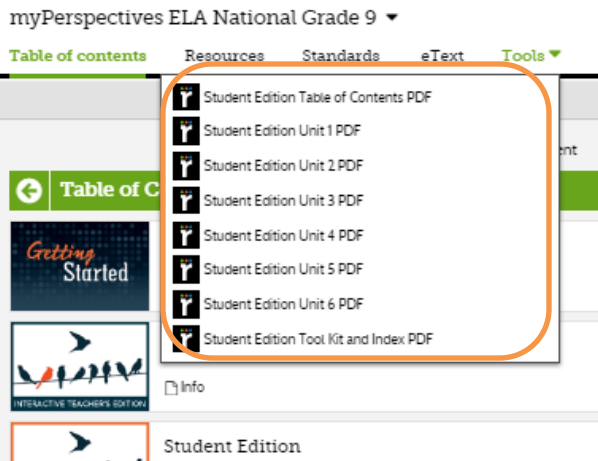
