New Year Rollover

New Year Rollover or NYR is a centralized process for EasyBridge Basic districts that prepares districts for the new school year. In previous years, only Pearson SuccessNet provided an automated NYR process. Now that Pearson EasyBridge includes a centralized class rostering service for Pearson Realize, Pearson SuccessNet, and Dash, the NYR process applies to those three platforms as well.

The NYR Process

The New Year Rollover marks the date when administrators can upload new classes on EasyBridge and teachers can create classes manually on Pearson Realize, Pearson SuccessNet, and Dash. The NYR process also deletes last year's classes, which removes students from classes, releases product license subscriptions, and deletes student progress data. The New Year Rollover process does not remove teacher content they have created, customized, or uploaded. Teacher and student accounts also remain in the system and should be reused each school year.

2017 New Year Rollover Date

New Year Rollover occurs June 30, 2017.

Options for District Administrators

New Year Rollover is mandatory, but this year district administrators can opt out of deleting last year's classes.

District administrators can opt out of class data delete for all schools in the district. By retaining class data, administrators will see both last year's and the current school year's classes on EasyBridge. Teachers will see both last year's and the current school year's classes on the integrated learning platforms. Teachers, however, can hide or expire classes to remove them from their list of active classes on Pearson Realize and Pearson SuccessNet.

For Teachers

- Ask if your District administrator plans to opt out of class data deletion.
- If your district does not have anyone to fulfill the District administrator role, assume your NYR date is June 30 and assume class data will be deleted.

Selecting Your Options

Districts electing to go through NYR on June 30th and opting to delete class data do not need to take any action.

Note about SuccessNet Plus

SuccessNet Plus is not integrated with EasyBridge. Classes must be manually created and inactivated or deleted directly on SuccessNet Plus by an administrator or teacher.
