



TX myView LevelUp Workshop Questions K-2 & 3-5

Q: Can you help us understand how to fit everything in during a 90+ minute block?

A: myView is a flexible program built with structures and supports to help differentiate and scaffold instruction for all Texas students. Begin planning with the *Week at a Glance* level planner. This will allow you to see all of the mini-lessons recommended for the week and allow you to make instructional decisions for your students. Also, consider using the *Quick Check* that follows each mini-lesson for formative assessment to guide your instructional choices and remember that many lessons in the Reading-Writing Bridge (the blue section) are flexible and optional depending on your students.

Q: The story is taking forever to go through. Can we break it up over days?

A: Yes! myView is a flexible solution. You can break the story up over days or even into chunks during your reading workshop. Be sure to consider the pacing of the week as you segment the selection and remember that many skills in myView spiral.

Q: Our kiddos are getting bored after 20 minutes of the story. Are we going into too much depth? What is your recommendation?

A: Consider using different methods for engaging your students while reading the text. Options can include: projecting the story through Pearson Realize, using the "Read Aloud" feature on Pearson Realize, creating different instructional groupings depending on the reading level of your students, (i.e. above level = independent reading, on-level partner or small group reading, below-level = small group with the teacher). Students may also benefit from being given a specific reason to read. To further engage students, refer to the teacher support boxes for linking learning - these will give suggestions for how to link the infographic (science and social studies content), the bridge (vocabulary, word study, etc) and other cross-curricular connections into your instruction.

Q: Can we use one Realize account for Kinder?

A: Every student will have their own account for Pearson Realize. This will allow them to be able to use all of the interactive features - including games, highlighting, circling, full audio, audio glossary and audio support for assessments in grades K-2.

Q: Are there Guided Readers besides nonfiction?

A: Our leveled readers include a variety of genres, aligned to the TEKS. You can find a complete listing of the leveled readers, including the genre of each in the *Small Group Guide*, beginning on p. 65.
